Child Protection

The Code of Ethics is derived from the *Code of Ethics for Youth Work in Aotearoa New Zealand* published by Ara Taiohi, the peak body for youth development in New Zealand. As a volunteer in a youth development organisation, you agree that at all times you will act responsibly towards young people and fellow volunteers. By accepting membership, you agree to uphold the Code of Ethics expected of adults in Scouting.
