In line with the accreditation process, you should seek to give at least 8 hours as a Dialogue Trainer designing and delivering courses and workshops and be an active mentor to further develop and apply your skills within your locality. You can actively engage as a Dialogue Trainer in a number of ways.

DIALOGUE FOR PEACE TRAINING

Designing and delivering dialogue training workshops is an integral part of your role as a Dialogue Trainer. Each training course/workshop should run for at least 2 to 3 days.
