

1 What do you estimate to be the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on your NSO/NSA’s membership growth¹ of young people this year?


69% estimated significantly or slightly lower membership growth



1.1 What are the reasons for the COVID-19 pandemic lowering the rate of membership growth of young people in your NSO/NSA? (you may choose more than one answer)

The top 4 reasons provided are:

- **Limited or no face-to-face local Scout meetings (87%, n=70)**
- **Limited or no face-to-face Scouting activities or camps (83%)**
- **Increased family or personal challenges stemming from COVID-19 (56%)**
- **Reduced income of parents to spend on children’s activities (49%)**


¹ The question asked about the impact of COVID-19 on membership growth. So lower membership growth means that the growth rate is lower than last year and not necessary an absolute decline in membership. This applies to the questions on growth of young people and adults.

2 What do you estimate to be the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on your NSO/NSA’s membership growth of Adults in Scouting this year?


68% estimated significantly or slightly lower growth of Adults in Scouting

The top 3 reasons are:

- **Limited or no face-to-face local Scout meetings (74%, n=69)**
- **Increased family or personal challenges stemming from COVID-19 (71%)**
- **Limited or no face-to-face Scouting activities or camps (70%)**




3 What percentage of the Scout groups in your NSO/NSA had to stop face-to-face meetings due to the COVID-19 pandemic?

72% (n=101) responded that between 75%-100% of Scout groups have stopped face-to-face meetings

83% (n=94) answered more than 3 months, with around half saying the meetings have restarted while the other half reported that there are still no meetings






3.2 What has been your NSO/NSA’s solution to not having face-to-face Scout group meetings? (you may choose more than one answer)




INCOME

Across the board decreased income is the most common experience for all sources, with one exception being government support for which more NSO/NSAs reported "no change" more than decreased income.



- Our analysis showed that there is still a need for an education of young leaders. Because of that, we organized combined training (online + offline) for 35 young leaders from all across Serbia.
- There were prepared some online and offline tasks by our Programme committee. Our members were able to do these tasks/challenges at home.
- A web page described above included activities offline - at home and outside in the city or nature.
- #Hike to Mahikeng - getting families to walk/run in their communities and collectively an individual did 20km. As a Group they qualified for a certificate if they collectively hiked 1290km - Cape Town to Mahikeng - the route BP did.
Covid badge of Namibia was adopted
Adult leaders gave tasks via WhatsApp for youth to do advancement and interest badges.
A young Troop scouter developed a programme with 100 tasks to do in 3 weeks, with a point system - it covered advancement activities. Many troops used it for the first 3 weeks of lockdown.
Rovers did community projects to collect food parcels, packed food parcels and did shopping for elderly that could not go out.
For Mandela Day, Jars of Hope was the challenge and Groups collected it. Jars of Hope contains, soup powders, lentils etc, to ensure 4 people could have a healthy meal by only adding boiling water and cooking it.
