

Humanitarian Action Bingo

Duration: 30 minutes

Type: in-person

Number of trainers: 1-2 facilitators

Number of participants: unlimited

Participants profile: Ventures, Rovers, Scout leaders, or other Adults in Scouting

Objectives: At the end of the workshop participants will be able to name various activities to engage in the community to support human rights

Note: This activity was designed to be facilitated at national or international jamborees. The approach and methods can be adapted by the facilitator to meet the educational purpose of the activity.

Activity description: Find a person, Scout or non-Scout, who has done one of the actions below and ask them to give their signature in the box of the action done. When you finish, return to the main point to receive the validation of finishing the challenge.
