Laskavo Scout financial support program

We continue to support Ukrainian girls and boys, as well as you - the sections and centers that invite them among you - and we are happy to announce **the continuation of the Laskavo financial support program**. Even after the summer, it remains possible to apply for financial support for the participation of Ukrainian girls and boys in the suburban camp and integration activities. We are now also adding support for regular participation in the departmental program.

Funding for the program was provided by the Vodafone Foundation and the European Scout Foundation. We can support Ukrainian girls and boys thanks to cooperation with the World Organization of the Scout Movement - WOSM and UNICEF.

Categories of financial support

1. Participation of girls and boys from Ukraine in suburban camps organized by your scout organization unit

- A suburban camp is typically a five-day camp with a daily program without overnight stays for the participants (detailed information and materials for organizing these suburban camps are now available on a special [signpost](#) at Skoutská kreizovatka).
- Maximum amount of contribution: 2500 CZK / 1 Ukrainian child for a camp duration of 5 days (you can apply for a contribution for more children).
- What can the funds be used for:
 - Child's participation fee (participation in the camp, food, entrance fee, transport, insurance, compensation for the head of the suburban camp, space rental, etc.)
 - Equipment for the child (backpack, high boots, etc.)
 - Part of the money can also be used for equipment for the camp, or the clubhouse, if the suburban camp takes place there

2. Leisure activities for Ukrainian girls and boys

- Leisure activities are understood as one-off and consecutive activities that provide Ukrainian girls and boys with the opportunity to spend quality and

pleasant free time, ideally with integration elements (joint participation of Ukrainian and Czech girls and boys, getting to know the Czech culture and language, etc.)

- Maximum amount of contribution 5000 CZK / activity. The activity must last at least 2 hours.
- What can the funds be used for:
 - lease space
 - purchase of materials according to the type of activity, refreshments, entrance fees...
 - sports equipment, clubhouse equipment, etc.

3. Involvement of Ukrainian girls and boys in the regular program of the section

- The contribution should be used by Ukrainian children involved in scouting groups to cover the costs of equipment for scouting meetings and expeditions (e.g. costume, KPZka, Novice, knot holder, sleeping bag, participation fees for expeditions, eshus, headlamp, rucksack for expeditions, etc.)
- The child for whom you are applying for a contribution does not have to be a registered member of Junák - Czech Scout.
- If the child is a registered member of Junák - Czech Scout, his membership fee can be paid from the Laskavo contribution.
- The maximum contribution amount is CZK 5,000 / 1 Ukrainian child.

Food for thought:

Let's keep in mind the economy and efficiency of the resources spent. From this point of view, the purchase of equipment (backpack, sleeping bag, mat, ...) for Ukrainian newcomers can look like they will only have this equipment on loan at first. In the event that the Ukrainian novices do not last long in your section for various reasons, this equipment will remain for use by other novices with limited financial background.

How to apply for a financial contribution

Very simply. Just fill out and submit this [form](#) .

Within one application (form), it is possible to apply for financial support from all three currently available categories - (1) Participation of girls and boys from Ukraine in suburban camps organized by your Scout organizational unit, (2) Leisure activities for Ukrainian girls and boys and (3) Involvement of Ukrainian girls and boys in the regular program of the section.

Conditions of financial support, approval process and reporting

- Only organizational units of the Junák - Czech Scout organization can apply for a contribution. Organizational units can apply for a contribution repeatedly.

- The children and youth for whose support the application is submitted do not have to be registered members of the organization Junák - Czech Scout.
- Applications will be accepted from 6.9. 2022 until the funds in the program are exhausted.
- The financial contribution can be used until June 30, 2023.
- Financial rewards for leaders can only be covered from the Laskavo program in the case of organizing suburban camps, as this is a demanding activity beyond the scope of normal scouting activities. In case of involvement of Ukrainian newcomers in groups and leisure activities, it is not possible to apply for funds to cover financial rewards.
- All applications that meet the conditions for granting financial support will be continuously approved in the order in which they were received until the funds are exhausted.
- If necessary, the organizational unit will be asked to supplement the information in the application.
- The applicant will receive notification within 7 working days of sending the application to the contact email provided by him.
- A donation contract will be signed with the successful applicant and money will be sent to the account specified in the application within 14 days of signing at the latest.
- The organizational unit that will be provided with funds from the Laskavo program undertakes to:
 - to use financial resources economically and only for activities fulfilling the goals and focus of the program,
 - within 30 days from the end of the activities, provide a brief evaluation of the use of support, i.e. fill in the form that we will send you,
 - provide min. 5 photos for each category (suburban camps / leisure activities / involvement in the regular program of the unit) from which the unit received funding from the Kindness program.
- The organizational unit is not obliged to send a financial statement to the provider.

Examples of the use of finance

Example of use of funds 1

A Ukrainian girl who attends a local school joined our Girl Scout troop during April. At first she didn't want to go on expeditions with the squad, later it turned out that she just didn't have the equipment and was too shy to ask for help. The equipment has been borrowed for now. She would like to join our department full-time from September. From the contribution of the Laskavo program, we will buy her a backpack, a sleeping bag, a mat and a costume and pay the membership fee.

Example of the use of funds 2

We have several active rovers and rangers in the center who decided to organize a suburban integration camp because they want to enable Ukrainian girls and boys from the area to experience a fun program during the autumn holidays and better integrate among local girls and boys. In advance, they found out that about 12 Ukrainian girls and boys and about 8 Czech girls and boys, some of them from scouts, would be interested in the camp. They are asking for the full amount of support for the Ukrainian participants, from which they will be able to buy, among other things, material for activities and relevant equipment for the clubhouse in which the suburban camp is held.

Example of the use of funds 3

At the meeting, our girl scouts and boy scouts talked about the fact that they would like to get to know the Ukrainian children in the area better and organize something for them. Together we came up with the idea of organizing two events for them - a sports afternoon and then a creative workshop in two weeks. In the Laskavo program, we are asking for support for two free-time events. At the first event, we will use the money to buy several sets of bats, balls, frisbees and small snacks. We will buy material and small refreshments for the creative workshop.
