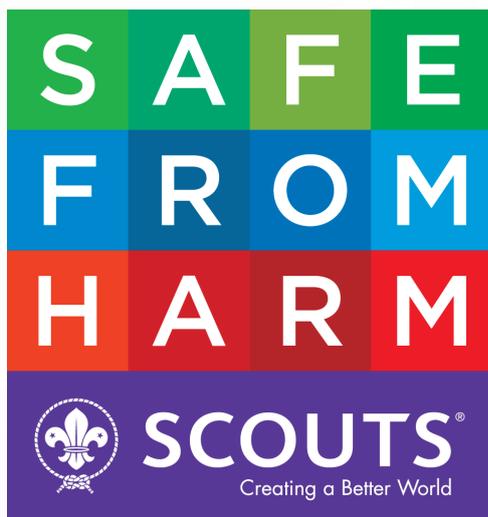

# DESCRIPTION

The Safer Scouting Champion plays a pivotal role in ensuring the seamless implementation of the Safe from Harm Policy and related procedures, as well as the Listening Ear Framework at our events. They work proactively to create and maintain a secure, safe environment for members, with a commitment to promoting the well-being of all involved. Someone within your team should assume this oversight role, from the initial division of responsibilities in the team and utilise the provided material and checklist to ensure full implementation.

# SOME OF WHAT YOU'LL DO



Ensure the effective implementation of the Safe from Harm Policy and provide support throughout the event



Monitor and mobilise compliance with Safe from Harm (SfH) event guidelines



Ensure implementation of the Listening Ear framework



Responsible for the coordination and oversight of the items in [wellbeing checklist](#)



Ensure necessary training is sourced and delivered for the planning team and participants prior to and/or during events



Oversee management of all SfH Cases by ensuring prompt responses and SfH procedures are followed



Proactively work with the planning team or participants to establish clear actions for promoting respect, openness, and inclusivity for all



Stay informed about national, regional and global events that may be impacting the community / individuals participating in the event and support the event planning team to consider the implications this may have for the participants (trigger warnings, sensitivities, personal circumstances, anxiety, etc)



Ensure the delivery of the SfH and Listening ear mechanisms at the beginning of the event and throughout where necessary



# WHO ARE YOU?

Safer Scouting Champions can be any adult leader or consultant in Scouting, including adult Scout Leaders who work as support workers or mental health professionals in their daily lives. You are seeking someone from your team, who feels they have the ability and capacity to take on this work, and who understands the obligations and the personal consequences.

You require an up to date [WOSM SfH2](#) e-learning certificate to fulfill this role. And you have:

- Strong personal and intercultural communication skills.
- Strong volunteers coordination and support experience.
- A willingness to learn and develop your skills as you go.
- The ability to maintain confidentiality and keep shared information secure.
- Be a team worker - responding promptly, and ask for help and raise issues as needed.
- Resilience - Be capable and willing to deal with challenging situations, with support.
