The Conference,

- **Recalling** Resolution 2024-02 of the 43rd World Scout Conference, which mandated the World Scout Committee to review and propose a new registration fee model for World Scouting;
- **Noting** the work carried out by the World Scout Committee through its appointed Task Force, as well as the feedback gathered from National Scout Organizations (NSOs);
- **Noting** that World Scouting's current registration fee system is based on membership numbers and economic indicators from 2009, and therefore no longer sustainable or equitable;
- **Reaffirming** the aim of distributing fee contributions more fairly across membership, grounded in updated economic and membership data, but without increasing World Scouting's total registration fee income.

Decides to:

- Adopt, in line with the requirements of Article XI.2 and Article XXIII.1 of the WOSM Constitution, the proposed WOSM Registration Fee Model as outlined in the Background Document annexed to this Resolution, to be applied as of the fiscal year 2026-2027;
- Designate the affordability and accessibility of World Scout events as a priority topic for the 44th World Scout Conference (2027), and tasks the World Scout Committee to develop a thorough analysis and proposals, in consultation with relevant stakeholders, to enable informed discussions and decision-making among NSOs.
