

VOTING PROCEDURE & BALLOT FORM

WOSM Registration Fee Model

In line with Article XI (4) and XII (4) of the WOSM Constitution, quorum, majority, and tie-breaking rules for voting shall apply in this electronic referendum. A quorum is established when at least one half the Member Organizations in good standing¹ have cast a ballot. Currently, there are 176 Member Organizations and, therefore, at least 88 Member Organizations must cast a ballot.

If a quorum is not met by the deadline for voting by electronic ballot, the deadline may be extended at the discretion of the World Scout Committee.

In accordance with Article XI (2) of the WOSM Constitution, a two-thirds majority of votes cast is required for the above resolution. A two-thirds majority of the Member Organizations casting a ballot in favour of adoption is required for the resolution to be approved. Where the votes "in favour" do not amount to at least two-thirds of the total votes cast, the motion shall be considered defeated

Only one voting option can be checked off in each vote, of either "in favour", "against" or "abstain". Abstentions will not be counted as either "in favour" or "against."

The completed ballot must be signed and submitted to the World Scout Bureau through **vote@scout.org** no later than **31 August 2026 at 23h59 GMT**, by the individual registered as the official NSO contact in the World Scouting Directory.

We strongly encourage every Member Organization to cast its ballot. Quorum is a shared responsibility, and meaningful participation matters regardless of how you choose to vote.

¹ A Member Organization is in good standing when it continues to meet the ongoing membership obligations set out in Chapter VII.3 of the WOSM Constitution including timely payment of annual registration fees, submission of required reports, adherence to WOSM's safeguarding and governance standards, and compliance with constitutional requirements. Good standing determines eligibility to exercise the full rights and privileges of membership, including participation and voting at the World Scout Conference, access to World Scout Bureau services, and eligibility for international events. For the purposes of this ballot, an NSO in good standing is one that has not lost its right to vote at the time the referendum opens whether through non-payment of fees, provisional suspension, or any other measure under the Constitution.
